'AI Ready' Communities is a three-month, cohort-based working program for community and customer leaders to optimise the incredible collective knowledge in their community for an AI-driven world.

This is not a course, and it's not a webinar series.

It's a guided, hands-on programme where a small group of organisations work through the same structural challenges together - supported by FeverBee's frameworks, facilitation, and direct input.

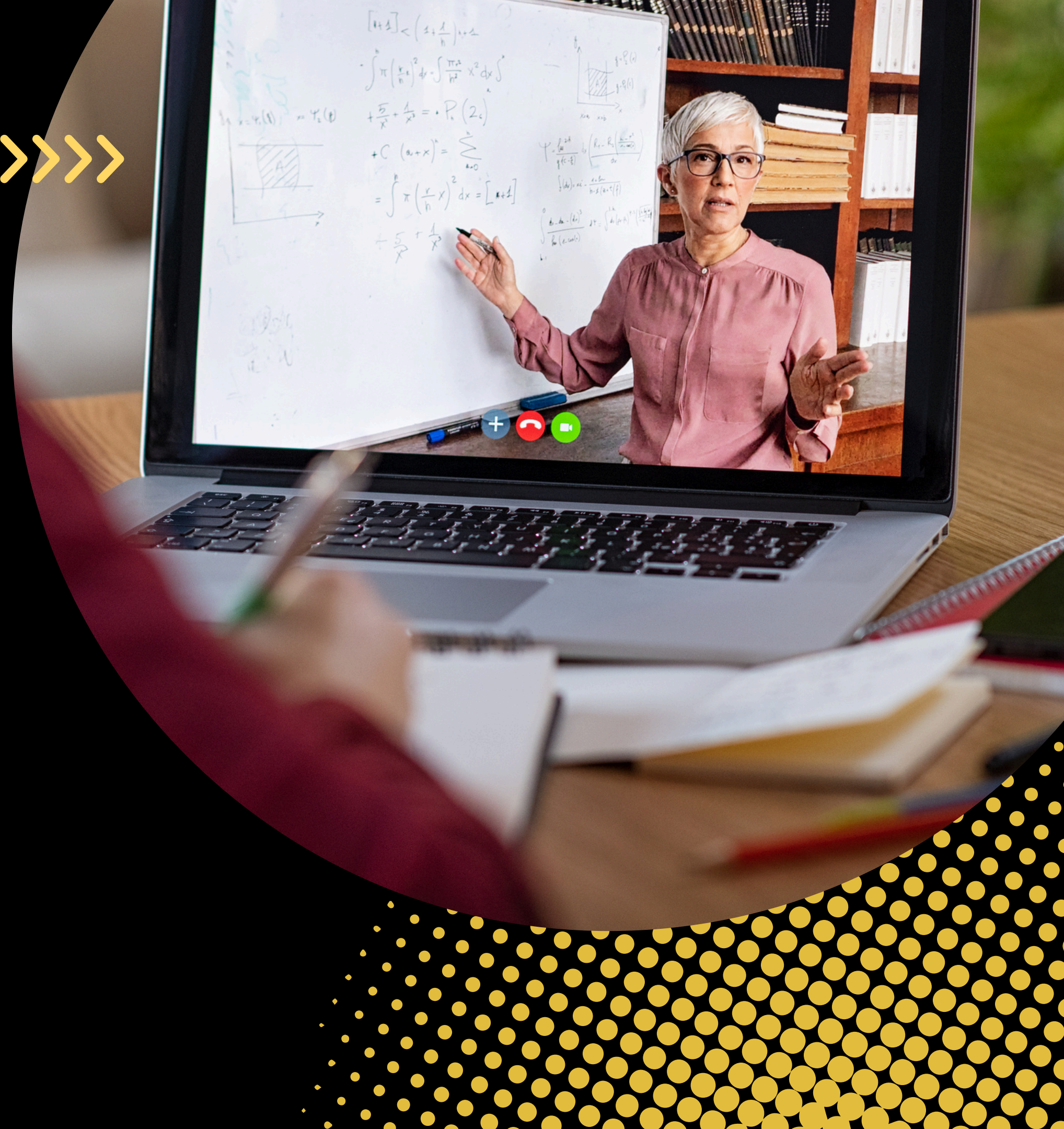
The focus is not on AI tools or vendor features; it's on ensuring your community is fit to be trusted, consumed, and amplified by AI.

MONTH 1

Evaluation And Risk Identification

This month establishes a clear, evidence-based view of how trustworthy, safe, and AI-ready your community knowledge really is before AI amplifies it at scale.

Assess knowledge trustworthiness

Evaluate whether content can be safely treated as accurate, authoritative, and reusable across customer and AI-mediated journeys.

Identify high-risk content areas

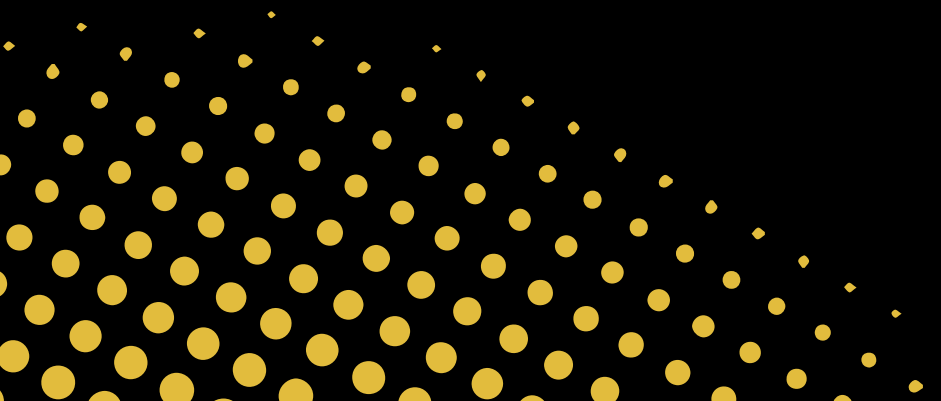
Surface duplication, contradiction, decay, and outdated guidance that could mislead customers or AI systems.

Evaluate expertise visibility

Determine whether real expertise is discoverable or buried beneath activity, noise, and unverified answers.

Map AI risk vs value zones

Identify where AI would genuinely amplify value today and where it would magnify errors or risk.





MONTH 2

Fix the Structure

This month prevents further damage and rebuilds the structural foundations required for community knowledge to scale safely and reliably.

Establish authority and verification

Define what counts as authoritative content, who can validate it, and how correctness is confirmed for high-impact topics.

Separate content intent

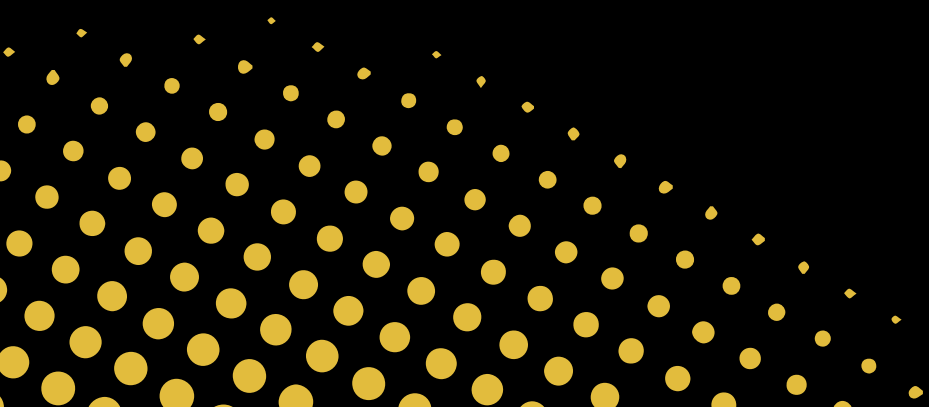
Clearly distinguish conversation, answers, and canonical resources so both humans and AI know what to trust.

Standardise structure and taxonomy

Clean up categories, tags, and navigation in critical areas to reduce ambiguity and misclassification.

Enforce “no new mess” rules

Introduce lightweight rules that ensure new content strengthens the system instead of degrading it.





MONTH 3

Signal Quality, Freshness & AI Enablement

This month prepares your community to be safely consumed, interpreted, and amplified by AI-driven systems.

Reduce ambiguity and conflict

Consolidate conflicting answers, define shared language, and align community content with docs, support, and CS.

Apply freshness signals

Label content as current, outdated, or deprecated and introduce versioning and review cadences.

Define AI guardrails

Decide where AI should and should not be used, with clear boundaries for safety, trust, and accuracy.

Establish the AI operating model

Set governance, escalation paths, and measurement so AI use is intentional and accountable.
